“Using evidence in everyday practice” - AM

For every patient, an orthodontist has to make a series of complex decisions on treatment recommendations. Of course, our education and experience play a large role in this process. However, as we accumulate more and more evidence, and as it becomes easier and easier to access, we can also include evidence in our daily treatment planning decisions. Dr. Huang will describe the use of evidence for treatment decisions on a real patient.

Objectives:

- ◆ Understand the levels of evidence, and why it is important to seek higher quality evidence
- ◆ Be able to access resources for finding evidence quickly
- ◆ Be knowledgeable on the current evidence for topics like TADs, accelerated
- ◆ tooth moment, self-ligation, and root resorption.

“Openbite treatment and stability” - PM

Dr. Huang will describe the etiology and treatment options for anterior openbite patients in the mixed dentition, in adolescence, and in adulthood. The literature will be reviewed, and examples of various techniques will be shown. Dr. Huang will also present preliminary findings from the National Adult Anterior Openbite Study. More than 90 practitioners and 347 patients were enrolled in this prospective study.

Objectives:

- ◆ Understand the etiology and treatment options for anterior openbite in the mixed dentition, adolescent dentition, and the adult dentition.
- ◆ Be able to compare current treatment recommendations from across the country.
- ◆ Be able to critically evaluate the openbite literature, and understand when case reports may present valuable information, and when they may be quite misleading.

Dr. Huang attended dental school at the University of Florida, after which he attended the University of Washington for his orthodontic education. He returned to practice orthodontics in Plant City, Florida for ten years. In 1999, Dr. Huang decided to pursue an academic career, and he accepted a faculty position in the UW Department of Orthodontics.

Over the years, Dr. Huang has been involved with numerous NIH-funded research projects, and he has published more than 50 scientific articles. He is well known as a proponent of evidence-based dentistry, and he recently co-edited an evidence-based orthodontics textbook. He has lectured nationally and internationally at many orthodontic meetings. Dr. Huang is a member of the American Association of Orthodontists, the Angle Society, and is a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics. He serves on the Editorial Boards of several orthodontic journals, and is an Associate Editor of the American Journal of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics. Since 2008, Dr. Huang has also served as Chair of the Department of Orthodontics at the UW.

Dr. Huang lives in Bellevue with his wife, Shu-Fen, and his two children, Lucas and Meghan. He enjoys racquetball, hiking, piano, and photography.
